- Who do you contact if you want to donate?
 - Call Echo Hill Outdoor School at **410-348-5880** and leave a message. Petey Rice, Boat Donation Program Manager, will return your call.
- What kinds of boats/ conditions of boats will you accept?
 - We will take any type of boat, power or sail. The condition of the boat can vary, the biggest thing is that we need to be able to sell the boat. If it is a classic boat that is popular as a fixer-upper, but is in rough condition, we would still consider it.
- What are the tax benefits?
 - Once the boat is sold, the final sale price is the amount that the previous owner can claim as a charitable donation
- How does the School benefit? What do the funds support?
 - All of the money from the sale of the boat will go to support programming at EHOS.
- Does the School actually USE donated boats?
 - EHOS will not use the vessel for any of our own programming—rather, 100% of the proceeds from the boat will be used to support EHOS programs.
- Does a boat need a title? What about a trailer?
 - It is certainly preferred to have a title for either boat or trailer but we will work with the owner if that is not the case.
- Will you take parts (just an engine) as opposed to an entire boat?
 - We will basically take anything that we can either use on our own or if it is an item that has value and is worth our time to sell.

- Will you come haul away a donated boat for the donor?
 - Yes! We will haul/sail or coordinate, depending on what is needed to get the vessel local.
